

Hello Educators,

As part of the new Careers2Communities (C2C) program from NMPED, schools across the state of NM now have access to the [Pathway2Careers \(P2C\) math curricula](#). These curricula offer a unique approach to math instruction, where math concepts are presented in the context of over one hundred high-value careers.

[MC2](#) (Mathematically Connected Communities) is partnering with [NS4ed](#) and the [College and Career Readiness Bureau](#) (CCRB) to support teachers in implementing this new career-focused mathematics resource designed for Algebra I and Geometry (8th Grade Math will be released in Fall 2021).

We encourage Geometry, Algebra I, and 8th grade teachers to **apply** to be a part of the **paid** pilot project for the P2C curricula. Pilot groups will start in March and run through May. Time expectations will be approximately 3-4 hours a week. This includes participating in a 1.5-hour virtual (PD) learning cycle to plan a P2C lesson, implementing the lesson with students, and providing feedback, both teacher and student, to curriculum developers. Teachers will be compensated (\$100.00) per each full completion of the planning and implementation cycle.
